No refunds for cancelled entries. No changes or substitutions or horses; NO EXCEPTIONS. Official post-mark will determine date of entry. Prize money will be mailed approx. 6 weeks after the show.

General Rules:

- The MPHE Fall Futurity is open to all registered PHBA and PHBA Bred horses or, in the case of weanlings, eligible to be registered with PHBA. Owners and exhibitors must be members in good standings with PHBA.
- Futurity classes will be held at the same time as the corresponding class in the regular PHBA show. Entries will be required to enter the corresponding open class.
- All futurity classes will be placed to 10 places, as entries 11) allow.
- 4) Yearlings and Palomino Bred 2yo's must enter a minimum of 2 futurity classes & Palomino 2yo's must enter 3 futurity classes to be eligible for the Fall Futurity All Around Championship buckle in their corresponding age group.
- 5) Official postmark will determine date of entry.
- 6) Futurity class entrants must be wearing the correct back number for the entry they are exhibiting.
- 7) Judging System: A total of six judge's scores will be used with horses exhibiting in two go-rounds. A judge for each futurity class will be designated as a tie-breaker judge in the event of a tie. The tie-breaker judge will be designated before any of the judges have judged a futurity class. Ties are broken for awards by designated judge, but monies are combined and divided evenly.
- No changes, refunds for cancelled entries or substitutions of horses, unless entry qualifies under Rule # 9 or 10.

- PRIOR TO THE SHOW: Notify futurity secretary, of any new information such as gelded stallions, names, sex, birth date, death, etc.
- 10) PRIOR TO THE SHOW: If the nominated horse should die, the owner's entry may be carried over to the following year. Owner must provide Veterinary death certificate to the futurity secretary.
- 11) The added money allocated to each futurity class is determined by dividing total amount of added money, by the total number of horses that showed to all 6 judges in all the futurity classes. The result is multiplied by the number of horses that showed to all 6 judges in a class. That total added to the entry fees collected for the class is then distributed according to the payback schedule.
- 12) Payback Schedule Payback will be determined by the number of horses shown to all 6 judges less 20% and paid on the following scale. See table below.

Payback schedule:

# of Entries	Payback
1	100%
2	60%, 40%
3-5	45%, 35%, 20%
6-11	40%, 30%, 20%, 10%
12+	30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%
